# Resolution

- What would God have us to resolve?

## Two things

- <sup>37</sup> And He said to him, "'YOU SHALL LOVE THE LORD YOUR GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART, AND WITH ALL YOUR SOUL, AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND.'
- <sup>38</sup> "This is the great and foremost commandment.
- <sup>39</sup> "The second is like it, 'YOU SHALL LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF.'
- <sup>40</sup> "On these two commandments depend the whole Law and the Prophets." (Matt. 22:36-40)

# Loving God

- Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, (Phil. 2:5)
- put on the new self, which in *the likeness of* God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth. (Eph. 4:24)
- If you love Me, you will keep My commandments. (Jn. 14:15)

# Loving God

- But whoever has the world's goods, and sees his brother in need and closes his heart against him, how does the love of God abide in him? (1 Jn. 3:17)
- whoever keeps His word, in him the love of God has truly been perfected (1 Jn. 2:5)

## Loving others

- In everything, therefore, treat people the same way you want them to treat you, for this is the Law and the Prophets. (Matt. 7:12)
- Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you. (Eph. 4:32)
- Tell the truth, don't sin in your anger, don't steal, let no unwholesome word come out of your mouth, remove all bitterness and anger (Eph. 4:25-31)

## Love others

- Don't forsake the assembly (Heb. 10:25)
- So then, while we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, and especially to those who are of the household of the faith. (Gal. 6:10)
