Micaiah – 1Kings 22

- Third war against Aram.
 - Following first, Aram said, “Their God is a god of the mountains but not of the plains.”
 - Second battle in the plains and Israel killed one hundred thousand in one day.
 - Prophet rebukes Ahab for making a treaty instead of destroying the king of Aram.
 - Third battle is Israel attacking.
- Jehoshaphat king of Judah – Ahab king of Israel – brought together by marriage.

1Kings 22

- Ramoth Gilead – one of the cities of refuge belonging to the tribe of Gad.
- Vs. 7 – How did he know?
- Vs. 8 – When feelings and self become more important than truth and right.
 - Ahab considered the words of Micaiah to be nothing but Micaiah's opinion.
- Vs. 13 – The request or command?
- Vs. 14 – The man of faith
 - No compromise, no middle ground, no agreement with anything different

1Kings 22

- Vs. 18 – Ahab made his words evil because they were not what he wanted to hear.
- Vs. 28 – “If you return safely, God has not spoken by me.”
 - Is it true?
