Dorcas

- Acts 9:36 – a life's summary
- Tabitha – Aramaic word, translated into the Greek language by -
- Dorcas – gazelle
 - Deer family
 - Because of large bright eyes – “see clearly”
- Vs. 32 – “saints” – sacred, holy, set apart for God's purpose
 - “the Lord's people” NIV in vs. 32
 - “the believers” NIV in vs. 41

Dorcas

- “In Joppa there was a female disciple”
- Disciple – “In all cases it implies that the person not only accepts the views of the teacher, but that he is also in practice an adherent. In the widest sense it refers to those who accept the teachings of anyone, not only in belief but in life.” (ISBE)
- “The disciple of Christ today may be described in the words of Farrar, as “one who believes His doctrines, rests upon His sacrifice, imbibes His spirit, and imitates His example.” (ISBE)

Disciple

- “Follow me”
- Intentional – not by accident.
- An intentional, continual and deliberate choice.
- “In Joppa there was a disciple.”
- Who said so?
- Matthew 7:22-23 – “I never knew you”

Dorcas

- Vs. 37 – “she fell sick and died”
- Vs. 38-39 – Peter comes
- Vs. 40-41 – the miracle
 - “If you believe”
 - “Seed money of faith”
 - Presented her to the ones who knew she was dead.
 - “She revived and gave me a message.”
- Vs. 42 – many believed in the Lord
