Romans 10:5-15

SIX THINGS

- Six things involved in our salvation:
 1. Hearing
 2. Faith
 3. Repentance
 4. Confession
 5. Regeneration
 6. Baptism

VARIOUS COMBINATIONS

- Faith and baptism
 - For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. For all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. (Gal. 3:26-27 NAU)
 - having been buried with Him in baptism, in which you were also raised up with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead. (Col. 2:12 NAU)

VARIOUS COMBINATIONS

- Faith, hearing and regeneration
 - In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation-- having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise, (Eph. 1:13 NAU)
- Baptism and regeneration (Rom. 6:4 & 7:6)
 - He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit, (Tit. 3:5 NAU)

VARIOUS COMBINATIONS

- Faith and confession
 - that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; (Rom. 10:9 NAU)
- Baptism and confession
 - 'Now why do you delay? Get up and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on His name.' (Acts 22:16 NAU)

VARIOUS COMBINATIONS

- Faith and repentance
 - and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel." (Mk. 1:15 NAU)
- Repentance, baptism, & regeneration
 - Peter *said* to them, "Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. (Acts 2:38

VARIOUS COMBINATIONS

- Faith, baptism, regeneration, repentance
 - Acts 19:1-5
- Acts 2:38 – faith not mentioned
- Romans 10:9 – regeneration, baptism and repentance not mentioned.

SIX THINGS (2)

Romans 10:5-15

SIX THINGS

- Six things involved in our salvation:

EACH WITH SALVATION

- Hearing
 - So faith *comes* from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ. (Rom. 10:17 NAU) – Matthew 7:24-27
- Faith
 - They said, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household." (Acts 16:31 NAU)

EACH WITH SALVATION

- Repentance
 - The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing for any to perish but for all to come to repentance. (2 Pet. 3:9 NAU)
- Confession
 - that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; (Rom. 10:9 NAU)

EACH WITH SALVATION

- Regeneration
 - He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit, (Tit. 3:5 NAU)

EACH WITH SALVATION

- Baptism
 - Corresponding to that, baptism now saves you-- not the removal of dirt from the flesh, but an appeal to God for a good conscience-- through the resurrection of Jesus Christ, (1 Pet. 3:21 NAU)
- Philippian Jailer & Ethiopian – more than a public statement - Christian
