1 Corinthians 10:13




"Till I die I will not put away my integrity from me. My righteousness I hold fast, and will not let it go; My heart shall not reproach me as long as I live."

Conclusion


"The stakes in eternity (i.e., the

We ought to be like the farmer's mule that fell into a pit.




We ought to have the same determination as we face the hardships of life—shake 'em off!
