# Romans 8

- 8:18-22 – sufferings as we wait for glory
  - *Are you suffering enough?*
    - Putting off our sinful desires.
    - Living faithful.

# Romans 8

- Vs. 23-28 – What sustains us – strengthens us?
  - Vs. 23-25 – *our hope.*
  - Vs. 26-27 – *the spirit.*
    - Intercession
      - *I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people-- (1 Tim. 2:1 NIV)*
  - Vs. 28 – *God's work.*

  - *Whom God foreknew*
  - *He predestined*

# Romans 8

## ■ Vs. 29-30

– *Whom God foreknew*

– *He predestined – proorizo*

■ pro – before / orizo – set apart, border, boundaries

– *Paul, a servant of Christ Jesus, called to be an apostle and set apart for the gospel of God-- (Rom. 1:1 NIV)*

– who was declared the Son of God with power by the resurrection from the dead, according to the Spirit of holiness, Jesus Christ our Lord, (Rom. 1:4 NAU)

# Romans 8

- Vs. 29-30
  - *Whom God foreknew*
  - *He predestined*
    - To be conformed to image of Jesus
  - *He called*
    - *He called you to this through our gospel, that you might share in the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.*  
*(2 Thess. 2:14 NIV)*
  - *He justified*
  - *He glorified*
