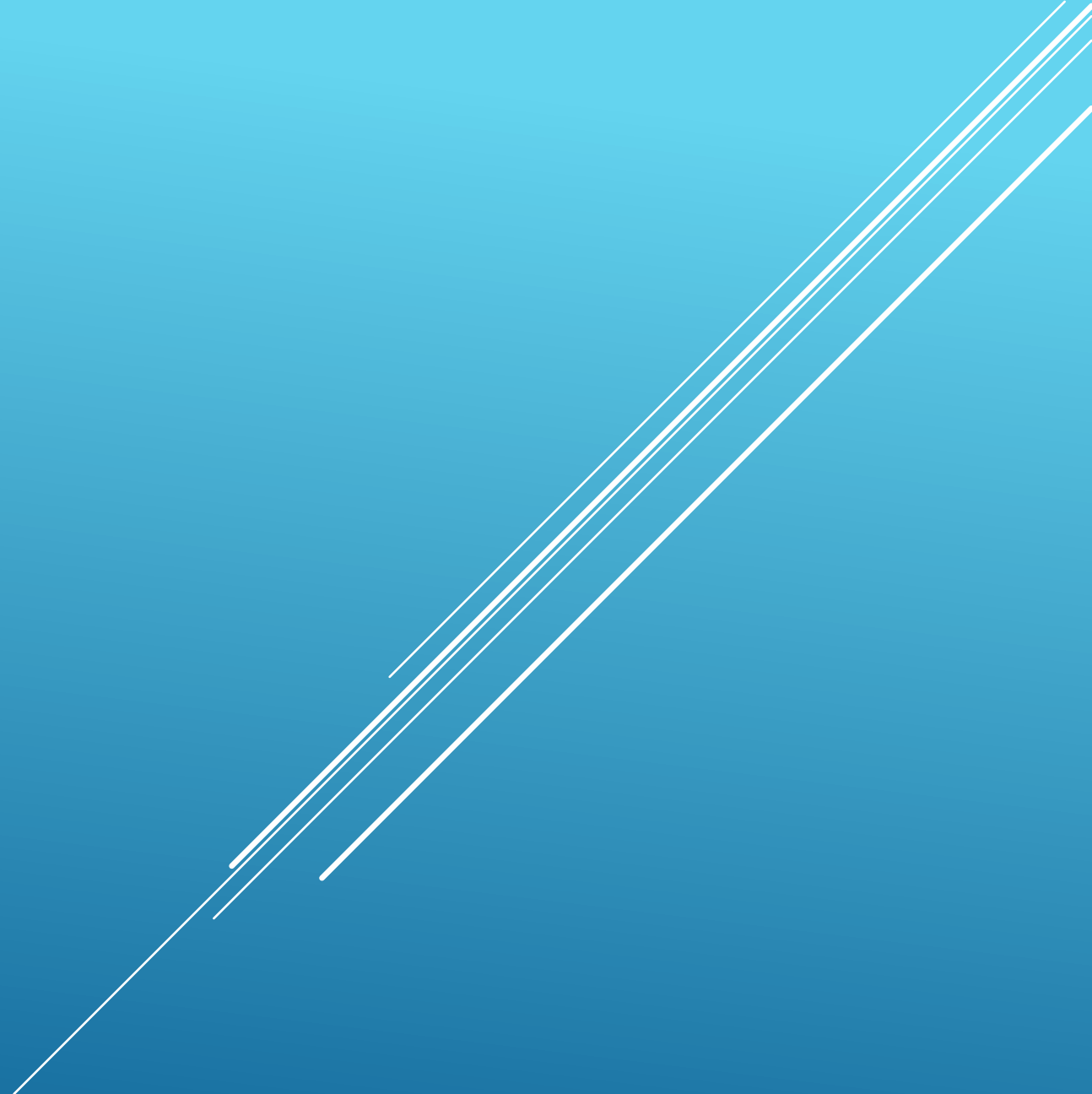


# PSALM 27
