# THE GOSPEL

- A gospel is an announcement of good news. In particular, the gospel is the announcement that Jesus' life, death, and resurrection have brought about salvation for Israel and the world. (Lexham Theological Wordbook)
- “euaggelion” (to pronounce “gg” = “ng”)
- The Ethiopian (Acts 8)
  - Reading Isaiah 53:4-6
  - Would he not also have read Is. 52:7?

## ISAIAH 52:7

- *How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace, who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion, "Your God reigns!" (Isa. 52:7 NIV)*
  - “tidings” – a good thing, benefit, welfare, happiness, prosperity – a good thing in every way
