- “the head of every man is Christ, and the head of the woman is man, and the head of Christ is God” (11:3)
- God – Christ – Man – Woman
- McGarvey – Pendleton Commentary on Thessalonians, Corinthians, Galatians, Romans
- “Subtle distinctions are to be made with caution, but it is not improbable that Paul’s order in this case is determined by the delicate nature of the subject which he handles. Dominion is fruitful of tyranny, and so it is well, before giving him dominion, to remind him that he also is a servant.”

1Corinthians 11:2-16

- “Again, the arrangement makes the headship of the man over the woman parallel to the headship of God over Christ and suggests that there should be between husband and wife a unity of will and purpose similar to that which exists between the Father and the Son.”
- “The unquestioned, immediate and absolute submission and concurrence of the Son leave no room for the exercise of authority on the part of the Father, and the infinite and unsearchable wisdom, love, benevolence and good-will on the part of the Father take from the Son every occasion of unwillingness or even hesitation.”
