Hebrews 10:19-25

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- “Do you know for certain, nothing doubting, that if you died today you would go to heaven?”
- “What is the most profound statement you have ever considered?”
- “Jesus loves me, this I know, for the Bible tells me so.”
- How do we know?

# Assurance

- Three views:
  1. You can't be certain in this life. That knowledge is kept in the mind of God alone. Fear and doubt belong to us in this life.
  2. You can know by receiving a direct communication from heaven leaving an impression upon your heart. They know they are forgiven because they “feel” forgiven.
  3. Faith in the word of God and obeying the conditions of salvation give us the full assurance that we are forgiven.

  - Physically - the five senses.
  - Morally - with respect to the mental and psychological as distinguished from the physical.

# Assurance

- *let us draw near to God with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water. (Heb. 10:22 NIV)*
- *"Therefore let all Israel be assured of this: God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Messiah." (Acts 2:36 NIV)*
- *For we know that if the earthly tent we live in is destroyed, we have a building from God, an eternal house in heaven, not built by human hands. (2 Cor. 5:1 NIV)*
