Spirituality

- What does it mean to be spiritual?
 - Spiritual – pertaining to the spirit or reason – opposite of fleshly, carnal, or worldly.
 - *"It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing; the words that I have spoken to you are spirit and are life. (Jn. 6:63 NAU)*

Does being spiritual mean perfection?

- *We know that the law is spiritual; but I am unspiritual, sold as a slave to sin. (Rom. 7:14 NIV)*
- *And you also were included in Christ when you heard the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation. When you believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, (Eph. 1:13 NIV)*
- *I would like to learn just one thing from you: Did you receive the Spirit by the works of the law, or by believing what you heard? (Gal. 3:2 NIV)*
