  - "Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth. (Matt. 5:5 ESV)
  - Psalm 37:3, 9, 11, 22, 27, 29, 34
- Matt. 5:21-26 – Luke 17:3 ( rebuke - appraise, show fault)– Mark 11:25-26
- Eph. 4:26-27 – Col. 3:8 – Titus 1:7 – James 1:19-22

- Some questions:
  - Am I being reasonable? Doing as I would want done to me?
  - Is my anger based in love?
  - Will my words and actions build up and protect or tear down?
  - Will my words and actions bring peace and unity or a deeper divide?
  - What do my words and actions say about the Lord I serve?
