# A question:

- ▶ *<sup>15</sup> And he said to them, "Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation. <sup>16</sup> Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. <sup>17</sup> And these signs will accompany those who believe: in my name they will cast out demons; they will speak in new tongues; <sup>18</sup> they will pick up serpents with their hands; and if they drink any deadly poison, it will not hurt them; they will lay their hands on the sick, and they will recover." <sup>19</sup> So then the Lord Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven and sat down at the right hand of God. <sup>20</sup> And they went out and preached everywhere, while the Lord worked with them and confirmed the message by accompanying signs. (Mk. 16:15-20 ESV)*

## A closer look:

- ▶ *“He appeared to the eleven” (vs 14)*
- ▶ *“These signs will accompany those who have believed”*
  - ▶ Accompany – used 4 times:
    - ▶ Mark 16:17 – “accompany”, KJV – “follow”
    - ▶ Luke 1:3 – “follow”, “investigate”
    - ▶ 1Tim. 4:6; 2Tim. 3:10 – follow
- ▶ How do you know Jesus and the apostle’s performed miracles?
